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2	Concrete works (Clause 1.2 in Page no. 65)	IT is mentioned in the tender document that bidder has to execute concrete repair works less than one Cu.m and more than one Cu.m will be executed by CPCL. Bidders requested CPCL to clarify on the number of concrete works, which are less than one Cu.m, to be carried out in a year.	Clause No. 1.2 in Page 65 of the tender document is replaced by the following: All Civil repair works connected with the Operation & Maintenance of the Plant equipment has to be carried out by the O & M contractor. Civil work includes cleaning of canals, tree cuttings, grass cuttings, housekeeping etc. Civil works comprising of Reinforced Cement Concrete (RCC) and Plain Cement Concrete (PCC) not more than one Cu.m. each for erection of new additional facilities like small pump foundations, etc. shall be done by the contractor. In a year, such foundations shall be done for 10 occasions, i.e. contractor is expected to execute 10 Cu.m of RCC and 10 Cu.m. of PCC. In total, for the contract duration of 3 years, the contractor is expected to execute a quantity of 30 Cu.m. of RCC and 30 Cu.m. of PCC. In case, if there is no need to execute the quantity in a year, such savings shall be executed by the O & M contractor in the subsequent years, as per the instructions of the Engineer in charge. Wherever there is a requirement of major civil works like renovation / major repair of the buildings / painting of buildings and major foundation work above one Cu.m. concrete will be carried out by CPCL or through the O & M contractor on payment basis at mutually agreed terms.
